## 2 Faculty of Management and Technology

## 2.1 Degree Program in International Industrial Management (TBB, SPO version 5.2)

- (1) This subject-specific part of the study and examination regulations of the Hochschule Esslingen for the Bachelor's degree programmes (SPO Bachelor) contains regulations for the Bachelor's degree programme International Industrial Management (TBB). It supplements the general regulations of the SPO Bachelor for the Bachelor's degree programme at the Hochschule Esslingen.
- (2) The degree of the study programme International Industrial Management is "Bachelor of Science" (abbreviated to "B.Sc.").
- (3) Graduates of the degree program should be qualified to work in an international environment in the following professional fields:
  - Change Management
  - Controlling, Accounting, Finance
  - · Purchasing, Procurement
  - Marketing
  - Production Management
  - Product Management
  - Project Management
  - Quality Management
  - Supply Chain Management
  - Technical Sales, Sales and After Sales, Key Account Management
  - Management-related staff functions

The focus here is on the special requirements of internationally operating companies.

- (4) It is not required to complete an internship before the programme.
- (5) The total amount of attendance time in the degree programme is 144 semester hours.
- (6) Students will initially not be admitted to the third semester if more than 11 ECTS credits are missing from the first two semesters; those affected will be informed in writing. Admission can be granted if the Dean of Studies approves an application after consultation.
- (7) The modules and sub-modules, marked with an asterisk (\*), including all coursework and examinations, are taught in English.
- (8) During the course of study, at least one study-related stay abroad of at least 90 days has to be completed.

The following are considered study-related stays abroad:

- a) study semester at a foreign higher education institution
- b) practical study semester abroad
- c) study-related voluntary internship abroad
- d) final thesis abroad.
- (9) The modules "advanced studies 1" and "advanced studies 2" of the sixth semester are chosen by the students from a catalogue which is announced by the faculty before the beginning of the lecture period. The catalogue lists the corresponding courses and required achievements. The advanced study classes can also be taken as electives at a foreign university.
- (10) For the module "compulsory electives", students from the 3<sup>rd</sup> semester onwards can choose compulsory elective subjects to the extent of at least 6 credit points from a catalogue which is announced by the faculty at the beginning of each semester.

The module grade is calculated in deviation from § 34 number I. paragraph 2 number 7 as the average of the individual grades weighted with the partial credit points.

Typical subjects that can be included in the compulsory elective catalogue are:

- Vehicle Design
- Vocational Pedagogy
- Electronics
- Foreign Languages
- Conflict Management
- Macroeconomics
- Passive Safety
- Programming Languages
- Service manager in the car dealership
- Behavioral Finance

Other subjects may be offered.

(11) The right to examination and admission to the TBB degree program shall expire if the student has not completed more than 19 module credit points in the first study section by the end of the second semester at the latest, unless the student is not responsible for the failure to meet the deadline.
