<u>Information about "blocked bank account" – Sperrkonto (for visa purposes)</u>

On order to get a Visa some applicants have to open a so called "Sperrkonto" (blocked account) with a German Bank before they can be issued a Visa. In this account there must be 10,236 Euros before a visa will be issued. When you arrive in Germany you will only be able to withdraw approx. 853 Euros per month from this account.

This means that when you have to withdraw a larger amount; for instance when your study fees are due to be paid in January and July, the bank will not allow this.
