Information about "blocked bank account" - Sperrkonto (for visa purposes)

On order to get a Visa, International Students must open a "Sperrkonto" (blocked account) before the visa can be issued.

Normally 11,904 € (992 € x 12months) must be deposited into this account.

However, the local immigration office insist on proof of your financial security for the whole of the study period (18 months) which means you will have to deposit another 5,952 € before they will consider a visa extension/residence permit until the end of the study period.

This means we highly recommend that you deposit 17,856 € at the outset!
