*** Miscellaneous expenses - minimum, day to day living costs such as clothes, food, learning material, toiletries, entertainment etc.

The Student union subsidise the cost of the following:

Student cafeteria, accommodation, childcare, loans and insurance, legal advice, psychological counselling, social counselling & funding.

The transport service fee covers the cost of public transport in the Stuttgart area (VVS) for students from Monday to Friday after 18:00h and all day on weekends and public holidays.

If you need to use transport outside of these times, you must purchase a "StudiTicket". This ticket covers transportation in the whole Stuttgart area 24/7.

Information about "blocked bank account" – Sperrkonto (for visa purposes)

On order to get a Visa some applicants have to open a so called "Sperrkonto" (blocked account) with a German Bank before they can be issued a Visa. In this account there must be 11,208 Euros before a visa will be issued. When you arrive in Germany you will only be able to withdraw approx. 934 Euros per month from this account.

This means that when you have to withdraw a larger amount; for instance when your study fees are due to be paid in January and July, the bank will not allow this.
