

These courses are part of our Bachelor's degree programs in Social Work and in Early Childhood Education. They can be taken by both our own students and by exchange students from our partner universities.

In addition, many of our social work students choose the Study Path INTERNATIONAL offered within the degree program and acquire international professional competence in three areas: international expertise, intercultural expertise and language expertise. Here, both our own students and exchange students will benefit from studying together, for example when comparing and analysing different social welfare systems.
