

| <p>Visa and Identification Requirements</p> | <p>Passports should be valid for at least six months after end of stay in Germany.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Guests from EU countries and Switzerland do not need a visa. They just need to bring their valid passport or personal identification card. • Some nationalities (e.g. USA, Japan, South Korea) can travel to Germany without a visa.
