

### Explore Germany's oldest sparkling wine cellar

Dive into the mysterious underbelly of the oldest sparkling wine cellar in Germany. Speyrer Pfleghof has been the headquarters of the KESSLER sparkling wine cellars for almost two centuries and is also one of the most important sightseeing attractions in southern Germany. A labyrinth of twelve interconnected vaulted cellars comprises the heart of the KESSLER sparkling wine cellar.

The glistening treasures are carefully stored in wooden racks in the depths of the medieval vaults. Speyrer Pfleghof was built in the early 16th century and housed the city's "tithe wine" over 600 years ago. Georg Christian von Kessler discovered and acquired this historical wine cellar for the production of exclusive sparkling wine.

During our cellar tour, you will learn about the life of the sparkling wine pioneer as well as the myths and stories surrounding this historic site. And of course, you will learn everything about the production of KESSLER sparkling wine.

### **Safety Information**

Participants taking part in KESSLER sparkling wine tasting events do so at their own risk. The cellar tour is only suited for persons who can move safely on uneven ground and who do not have difficulties with stair climbing. Visitors should wear warm clothing and sturdy shoes. Even in high summer, cellar temperatures never rise above 13° Celsius.

Our offer is aimed primarily at adults over 18 years of age. Minors may only participate in a guided tour and tasting if accompanied by a parent or guardian.



### Meeting point

Sparkling wine cellar KESSLER in Georg-Christian-von-Kessler-Platz at the main entrance behind the town church of St. Dionys
